

MONTHLY FOCUS & RATIONALE

FAMILY - CALLED TO NURTURE FAMILY VALUES AND RELATIONSHIPS



he path to being Pilgrims of Hope through Synodality is clearly possible with the return to examine the basic principles that lie at the foundations of Christianity and the gradual shifts that have taken place over the recent past. It is imperative that we begin with our basic belief that God as Creator of the Universe and the World had an intention and purpose and the result was something God saw "was good" (Genesis 1). Creation story moves next to the man and woman and God saw it was "very good".

It was obvious that the God of the Universe outside is also the same God of the inside, the soul of human persons but with a difference: the implanted laws and dynamics were fixed to work in harmony in the Universe. However, Human Persons were intended by God to also experience this same harmony but with a dangerous clause; "I give you freedom to make decisions in your life" and we know what happened to Adam and Eve and also to Cain and Abel.

With the insights of life blurred, the process of discernment to differentiate between good from evil and the capability to make decisions is lost. Decisions made are based only on SELF interest but not necessarily in accordance with the Will of God the Creator. Thus, it is firm in our Scriptures that we cannot separate God from the Universe and the World, God from the Human Person and the Human Family.

Our Christian Faith intrinsically interrelated with the Will of God is not predetermined fate but the willingness of the followers of Jesus to journey as a People of God Our Father, keeping on the path of Jesus and with the Spirit of Jesus in our hearts and our lives. This is the quintessence and embodiment of Synodality, without which activities will turn to activism, our words into rhetoric and lives as lights under the table.



Job Description


- Counting and reconciling all Church Cash Collections and depositing all cash to Church RHB Accounts promptly.

- Payroll preparation and payment through Banking on-line system
- Statutory payments EPF/Socso done through Banking on-line system
- Computation and remittance of Solidarity fund and other pass through amounts to Diocese through on-line banking system
- Compiling and filing all source documents supporting transactions vendor invoices, utility bills, banking in slips, bank statement etc and inputting into Arkdios system.




